## Sermon Notes: Lesson in Pictures Part 1

- 1.) Thanks to all who make MCOC a brighter place!

- 3.) The Crooked Yucca: Obviously I am viewing the “crook” as an imperfection... but I certainly don’t believe that an imperfection makes you \_\_\_\_\_. Nor does a struggle deem you \_\_\_\_\_.
- 4.) Luke 12 says the very hairs of your head are \_\_\_\_\_.
